The Indiana Artists Club, Inc., was founded in 1917 by a group of forty-six artists including such notables as T. C. Steele, William Forsyth, Otto Stark, Carl Graf, Wayman Adams, Simon Baus, Marie Goth, Frederick Polley, Clifton Wheeler, Randolph Coats, Carl Lieber and Alex Holiday. The organization's name was changed to Indiana Artists in 2015.

The purpose of the Indiana Artists organization is to hold statewide exhibitions, workshops, demonstrations, and to provide social interaction among its members. A board of directors, elected yearly, leads the organization. The organization has sponsored annual exhibitions since its inception. The Annual Juried Exhibition is held each spring at the Indianapolis Museum of Art. The Annual Members Exhibition is held each fall at various locations throughout Indiana.

Exhibitions of the current membership are composed of a wide variety of styles and mediums, both contemporary and traditional.

To become a member, it is necessary to have been born in Indiana *or* have been a resident for two years. In addition, you must have been accepted into three differently sponsored exhibitions (with out-of-state judges) with three separate works of art.

Exhibition Juror

We are pleased to have as this year's juror, painter and educator Robert Kingsley. Kingsley was educated from both Tyler School of Art in Philadelphia and Indiana University. Kingsley's primary subject is the human figure with landscape as his second love. Focusing on the "romantic", his paintings evolved to a more narrative subject presentation.

Reading Joseph Campbell and an extensive tour of European museums became central to his artistic development. Myths and legends came into focus as his reference point for stories of mankind with a modern guise. Great painters of the past also fuels his passion for painting. Kingsley's still-lives and landscapes allow him to work with a different genre while southern Indiana being the impetus for his treks to the fields outside his studio.

Kingsley is Professor Emeritus of Art and Art History at DePauw University, teaching from 1976-2012.

Brown County Art Gallery

Indiana Artists would like to thank the Brown County Art Gallery for hosting this year's exhibition at the museum.

The Brown County Art Gallery was established in 1926 by the early members of an important regional art colony who began exploring rural southern Indiana in the 1890s. These early artists had been trained in the best art schools of Europe and America and were attracted to the rolling hills of Brown County.

It is all part of an ongoing history that began more than eight decades ago when Hoosier Group Master, Theodore Clement Steele, bought property in Brown County in 1907. He encouraged many other prominent artists to visit Brown County. They fell in love with the rugged land, declaring it their "perfect painting ground" and opened studios in Brown County, nicknaming it "Peaceful Valley."

In 1926, they formed the Brown County Art Gallery Artists Association and set up a Gallery, making it one of the oldest galleries in the United States. Visitors to the Brown County Art Gallery will still find the work of today's top Indiana artists for sale and can learn the history of those who came before.
